AUSTIN – The Texas Veterans Commission is pleased to announce the winners of the 2019 TVC Employers Awards. These awards recognize both public and private-sector employers whose efforts and initiatives have had an extraordinary effect on Texas veterans, other employers, workers, and the communities in which the employer does business. Employer recognition is an integral part of TVC’s ongoing appreciation for businesses in the community who show an outstanding commitment to employing veterans. By shining a spotlight on deserving employers, TVC cements and expands these relationships and creates long-term productive partnerships. Two of the 2019 award winners are located in Abilene and will be recognized at the Workforce Solutions Board Meeting on Wednesday, February 19, 2020 at 12:00pm on the 12th floor of the Enterprise Building.

CDTS, Inc., (Medium Employer-51-250 employees) - The company had a workforce of 122 of which 25% were veterans. They hired 60 individuals during the year in which 23% were veterans.

Texas Aerospace, Abilene, TX (Small Employer-50 or fewer employees) - The company had a workforce of 40 of which 70% were veterans. They hired 17 individuals during the year in which 82% were veterans.
